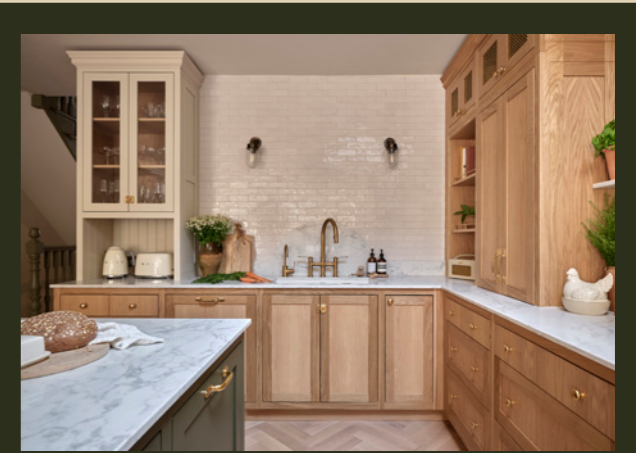


Barnes

Farmhouse warmth with just a hint of urban edge – this is a kitchen that effortlessly blends the traditional and the contemporary.



The kitchen is full of honest, natural materials. Oak shaker doors with lovely natural grain. Whitewashed brick, marble splashbacks and worktops. And a no-fuss floating shelf for everyday essentials (or your best crockery, if you're showing off).



Barnes is full of beautiful yet unfussy details. Meshed cabinet doors break up solid runs and add character. Perrin & Rowe taps lend a hint of tradition, while the mix of pendant lighting and natural daylight keeps things feeling bright and relaxed





Anmer

Mixing exposed walnut, scalloped doors, fresh blue shaker cabinets and a marbled splashback that cascades onto the worktop, the Anmer kitchen is all about sumptuous layers of texture and colour.

The scalloped wall cabinet provides gorgeous texture - imagine the satisfaction of running your fingers across that surface... And the natural walnut colour is echoed in the interior of the bespoke pantry cabinet.



The colour palette is very contemporary, with cabinets in a fresh blue and a rich purple - but combining the paint finishes with exposed timber elements gives the kitchen a timeless look.





Grosvenor

The Grosvenor kitchen is a celebration of natural walnut - a combination of unstained timber and modern features that is at once contemporary and timeless.



Taking inspiration from mid-century modern design, the Grosvenor kitchen is all about clean lines and understated elegance. The sleek horizontal and vertical bar handles complement the natural wood grain, enhancing the symmetry and simplicity of the cabinetry.



Clever storage solutions are at the heart of the Grosvenor kitchen. Pocket doors make the most of available space, seamlessly concealing appliances and keeping the kitchen feeling open and uncluttered.

Camden

A kitchen of contrasts: rich oak, soft pink walls, dramatic quartz, and a view that brings the garden inside.



Not everything deserves to be on display - which is why Camden has the perfect mix of open shelves (for your ceramics, or just that one nice jug) and sleek cupboards to sweep everything else behind.



Dark stained oak cabinetry is the star here - not a bland flat panel in sight, but proper timber with grain you can actually see and touch. Pair that with a stunning quartz splashback and suddenly the pink walls feel less daring and more perfectly at home.



There's something about standing in this kitchen that instantly lowers the pulse rate. Maybe it's the soft light bouncing off the quartz, maybe it's the parquet floor underfoot, or maybe it's the glimpse of greenery out the window. Whatever it is, it works.





Chester Row

A stunning family kitchen featuring classic shaker cabinets, magnificent marble worktops, and bespoke touches.



The walnut island is the focal point, but oak is used in a different aspect of the kitchen, showcasing glistening crystal glasses in glazed counter-standing cabinets, alongside a breakfast area.

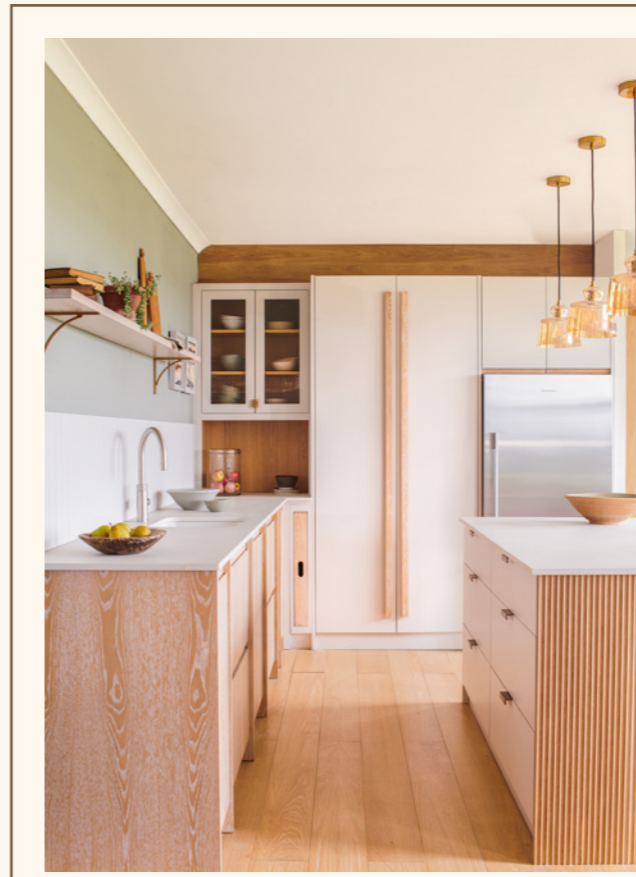


The hidden bespoke touches in this kitchen help to ensure it remains a working family kitchen, whilst never impacting the beauty of the design.

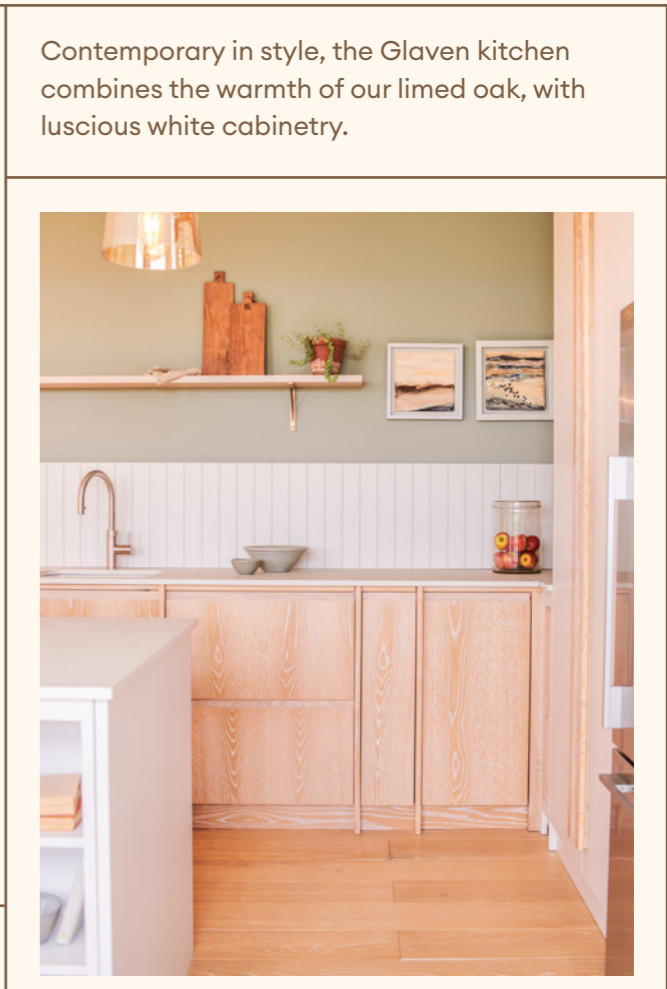


Glaven

Sleek, modern and functional: The Glaven kitchen features a brushed limed-grain oak finish with white cabinetry and Caesarstone concrete worktops, complete with open shelving and ample storage space.
